



## Yet Another PVC Creation

A friend came up with this idea. The Suzuki DR 650 has a plastic tool bin located this way. My friend saw this & it was a short leap to this for the KLR.

**VARIATIONS** This one is made of electrical conduit because I like the gray. My friend made his is all white PVC. He used screw caps on both ends. This one is secured at the bottom by a hose clamp. The other one has a metal strap hooked into the strip that holds the side panel.

**SKILL** The only skill required is bending the top strap and then off-setting it to fit under the side plate.

**USE** It is a good place to store seldom used items like spark plug, plug wrench, extra handle bar lever set, chain link, misc. screws & bolts, socket set, allen wrench, etc. For my first time use, I have crammed the tools in the tube - for maximum storage. Later, I may make a sack so that I can withdraw the tools without removing the tube.

**WITH USE, I LEARNED TOTAL LENGTH SHOULD BE 12" TO 13". THE ORIGINAL HIT CHAIN GUARD.**
